

## PRACTICAL INFORMATION

### REGISTERING WITH THE "ANAGRAFE"

#### GENERAL INFORMATION:

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Students from EU member states, from Switzerland, Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein who intend to stay in Italy for more than 90 days must register at the local "anagrafe" offices of where they are staying.

#### DOCUMENTS FOR REGISTERING WITH THE "ANAGRAFE":

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To register with the local "Anagrafe" office, you will need the following documents:

- A valid passport or equivalent document;
- Fiscal code;
- An apartment rent contract or a declaration from the owner of the apartment where you are staying that you are a guest.
